## State Testing-Parent Meetings

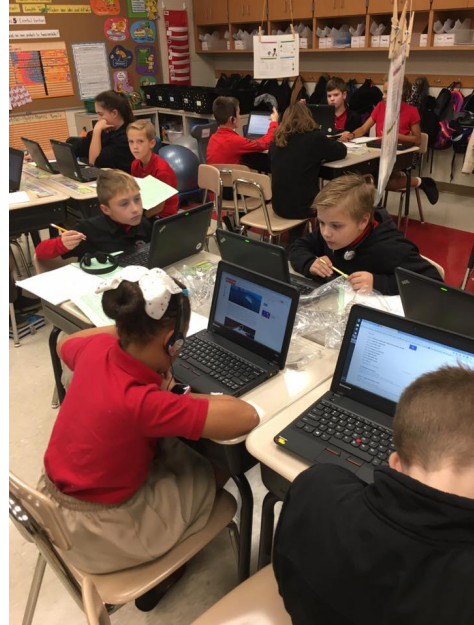

Dr. King is known for being one of the greatest leaders in the Civil Rights Movement in the United States. Through his dedication and activism, Dr. King played an important role in ending the legal segregation of Black people in this country. He tried to bring about equality and justice for all. His Work influenced his son Martin Luther King III, who, the 50th Anniversary of his father's "I Have a Dream" speech, said:  
*This task is not done. The journey is not complete. We can do and must do more.* His words remind us that part of Dr. King's legacy is to never stop fighting for justice.

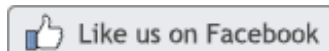
